Keynote Speaker

Helen M. Carroll

Helen served as the Chairman of the Board for the Northern Kentucky Chamber of Commerce in 2006. She is currently a member of the Gateway Community and Technical College Foundation Board, the United Way of Kentucky Board of Directors, the Kentucky Press Association Board of Directors, and she currently serves as chairman of the Governor's School for the Arts Advisory Council. Helen is member to the Regional Stewardship Council for Northern Kentucky's Vision 2015 and is chair of the Vision 2015 Educational Excellence Implementation Team.

Ordained in 1999, Father Wurth began his priestly service to the Diocese of Covington as parochial vicar of Saint Pius X Parish, Edgewood. In 2002, he was named administrator, and later, fifth pastor of Mary, Queen of Heaven Parish in Erlanger, a position he currently holds. In addition to his parish assignments, Wurth has served as chaplain to Newport Central Catholic High School, Covington Catholic High School, and Saint Henry District High School.

Wurth serves on the Board of Trustees and the Foundation Board of Thomas More College, Crestview Hills, KY. Bishop Roger J. Foy appointed Wurth to the College of Consultants for the Diocese of Covington in 2004. He was also appointed by the Bishop to the Presbyteral Council for the Diocese in January 2006. In addition to these longer-term memberships, Father Wurth occupies positions on several ad hoc committees relating to diocesan ministry such as the Diocesan Board of Education Ad Hoc Committee on School Marketing and the Boone County Planning Task Force of the Diocese of Covington. Additionally, he serves on the Diocesan Religious Education Task Force and the Presbyteral Convocation/Clergy Continuing Education Committee.
